ELIGIBILITY

The Elsah Photography Exhibit and Competition is open to all photographers

TWO THEMES!!

Choose either or both of them! **1. Native Species:** Designed to honor our village's ongoing efforts to re-establish native species all along the wetlands and creek ways in Elsah; this effort has spread even into yards and public spaces and has several stellar periods of bloom! We're stabilizing our creek banks, improving habitat, cleaning our creek, and beautifying our Village!

2. Historical Abstraction:

Designed to encourage the use of our historical surrounds to find and create breathtaking, uncommon compositions of the historical built environment. Close- up details, unusual lighting, shadows and out-of-the-way views are the ticket!

SUBMISSIONS

For the jury process, we accept high-quality, digital images of photography (no film).

All works must be original and completed within the last two years. Works previously exhibited in the Elsah Photo Exhibit are not eligible. Upon being accepted, all photographs must be shipped and framed, ready to hang with a wire. Framed works cannot exceed 16" x 20". SHIPPING

Accepted work may be mailed, shipped to HEF, PO Box 117, Elsah, IL 62028, or hand-delivered to the Elsah Village Museum, 26 LaSalle, St, Elsah, IL 62028, at the photographer's expense. Mailed works must arrive by 03.01.24, with return postage. Hand-delivered works must arrive on either Saturday or Sunday, 03.02 or 03.03.24, 1-4pm. Works must be in well packed, reusable cartons, or crates. All must have wires for wall hanging. Plexy must be used, No Glass!

HOW TO ENTER

NEW! : Entry form and digital submissions preferred via on line form at https:// historicelsah.org/photocomp/ You can fill out your entry form, easily upload you photos, and pay your entry fee all online this year!

Entry form must be complete, indicating the photographer's name, contact info (including email), the title of the work, description, year made, dimensions framed, and insurance value.

Each image file must be identified with the entrant's last name and entry number (1,2, or 3). Three digital images per \$15 entry fee; one entry fee per photographer.

Digital images must be submitted in JPEG or TIFF format, and must be a minimum of 300DPI, 4x6 inches and a max file size of 7MB.

Submissions hand delivered or mailed with images (on a non-returnable flash drive) are also accepted. Include entry form and a nonrefundable \$15 personal or cashier's check payable to Historic Elsah Foundation (Photo Exh), postmarked no later than Jan 06, 2024 to: Elsah Photography Exhibit Historic Elsah Foundation | PO BOX 117 Elsah, Illinois 62028
